Mary Wells, L.C.S.W. is the President and the C.E.O of Family Service of Burlington County. Mrs. Wells has been involved with the Agency since it first offered Services in 1968 and has been its principal since 1978.

Having earned the Bachelor of Arts degree from Drew University in 1964, Mrs. Wells continued her education at the Rutgers School of Social Work, earning the Masters of Social Work degree in 1967. She became a New Jersey Licensed Clinical Social Worker in 1994

Mrs. Wells was the first chair of the New Jersey Department of Human Services Children's Coordinating Committee from 1987 through 1991. From 1991 through 1995, she chaired the New Jersey State Human Services Advisory Council and Executive. Mrs. Wells is a Trustee for Virtua Health.

Among the awards Mrs. Wells has received are: Administrator Recognition Award from the Alliance for the Mentally Ill; New Jersey Social Worker of the year in 1990; the Humanitarian Award from the New Jersey Region of the National Conference of Christians and Jews in 1992; and the Martin Luther King Award of the Education Committee of the Second Baptist Church in 1984 for work in the field of public service and human relations.
